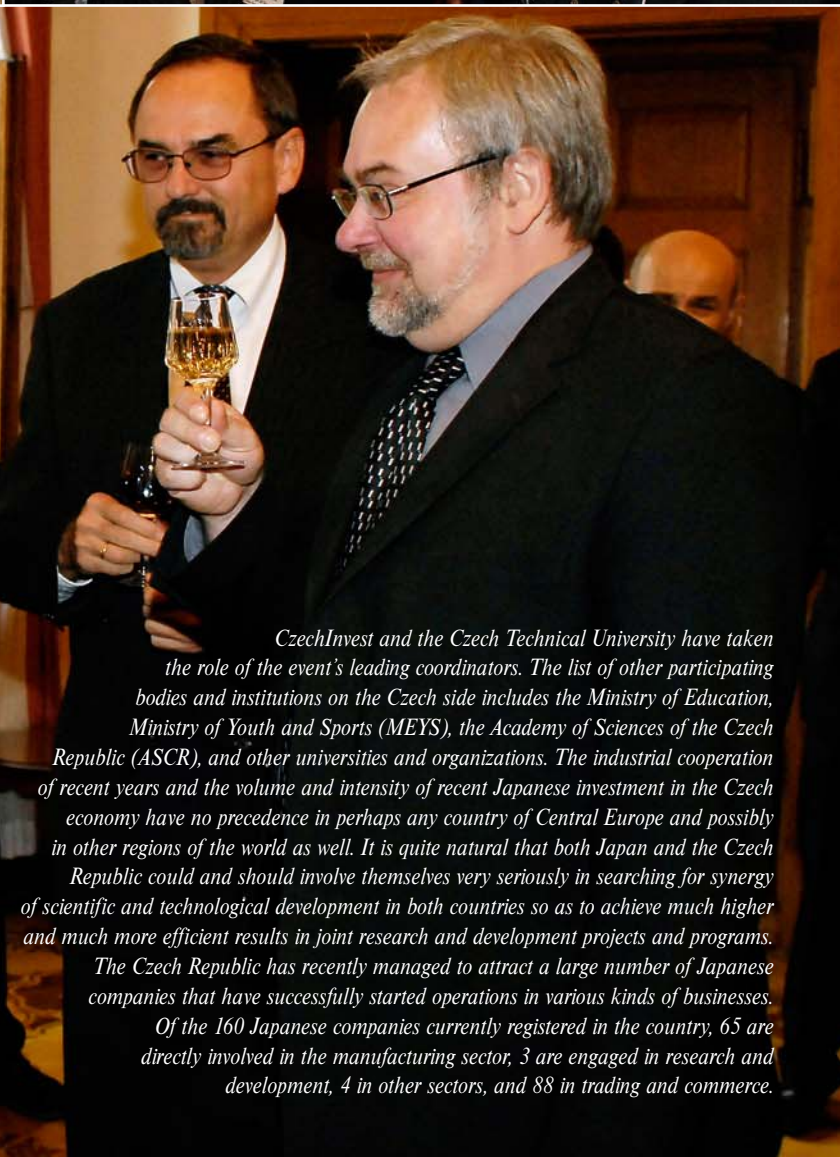

*CzechInvest and the Czech Technical University have taken the role of the event's leading coordinators. The list of other participating bodies and institutions on the Czech side includes the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Youth and Sports (MEYS), the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic (ASCR), and other universities and organizations. The industrial cooperation of recent years and the volume and intensity of recent Japanese investment in the Czech economy have no precedence in perhaps any country of Central Europe and possibly in other regions of the world as well. It is quite natural that both Japan and the Czech Republic could and should involve themselves very seriously in searching for synergy of scientific and technological development in both countries so as to achieve much higher and much more efficient results in joint research and development projects and programs. The Czech Republic has recently managed to attract a large number of Japanese companies that have successfully started operations in various kinds of businesses. Of the 160 Japanese companies currently registered in the country, 65 are directly involved in the manufacturing sector, 3 are engaged in research and development, 4 in other sectors, and 88 in trading and commerce.*
